Sale Report:

Number's increased to see 3000 head penned for Emerald sale today. With a healthy season supporting Central QLD, good quality runs were presented for sale across all categories yarded. The market largely maintained rates from the previous week, the exception being heavy cows over 520kgs, easing by 8-12c/kg, despite the good quality stock offered. Bullocks over 550kgs sold to 354c/kg to average 344c/kg, heavy steers 500-550kgs coming under slaughter & feeder competition reached 354c/kg to average 346c/kg, heavy heifers over 400kgs made to 336c/kg to average 311c/kg, heavy cows over 520kgs topped at 297c/kg to average 287c/kg, cows 450-520kgs made as much as 295c/kg to average 282c/kg, while bulls over 600kgs sold to 287c/kg.

In the store section, heavy feeder steers 400-500kgs sold to 376c/kg to average 359c/kg, 350-400kg steers topped at 438c/kg to average 356c/kg, 280-350kg steers made as much as 438c/kg to average 357c/kg, 200-280kg weaner steers reached 446c/kg to average 369c/kg, Steers under 200kgs made to atop of 438c/kg to average 343c/kg.

Trade feeder heifers 350-400kgs sold to 331c/kg to average 300c/kg, 280-350kg heifers topped at 331c/kg to average 290c/kg, weaner heifers 200-280kgs made as much as 322c/kg to average 278c/kg, while Heifers under 200kgs made to 288c/kg to average 265c/kg.

The Cow and Calf market was reasonably stable for the quality yarded, with only 17x17 in hand, The best of the crossbred cows & calves, medium frame, with calves from 1-5 months old, sold to a top of \$1260/unit.
