Sale Report:

Emerald agents yarded just shy of 2500 cattle for the 2nd sale of the year. Today we saw the slaughter market hold stable with some really good quality cows been yarded, there for that market only softening from 5-10 cents in areas. The store sector was heavily competed, with good quality cattle being rewarded, being 5-10 cents better at the top end.

Cows over 520kg topped at 288c/kg and averaged 278 cents, cows 450-520kg reached 282c/kg and averaged 278cents.

Heavy steers over 550kg topped at 349c/kg to average 338 cents. Steers 500-550kg were only few to quote but topped at 341 cents and averaged 333 cents, steers 400-500kg reached a top off 279c/kg to average 350 cents, Steers 350 to 400kg topping at 374 c/kg to average 320 cents, Steers 200-280 kg topping at 460c/kg to average 386 cents.

Heavy heifers over 400kg reached 331c/kg to average 299 cents. Heifers descripted from 350-400kg got out to 310c/kg to average 275 cents, 280-350kg heifers topped at 318c/kg, while heifers 200-280kg topped at 342c/kg to average 252 cents. Heifers up to 200 kg topped at 290 c/kg to average 252c/kg.

Cows over 520kg topped at 211/kg and averaged 200 cents, cows 450-520kg reached 198c/kg and averaged 181 cents.
