<u>Sale Report</u> Number's decreased by almost 1200 with Agent's offering 1800 head at today's Emerald sale. Quality was fairly mixed, and the market couldn't maintain the pace from the previous weeks rates. Slaughter descriptions eased due to oncoming weather events aiming for southern QLD & northern NSW as processors deal with what the future holds. The store market remained firm for the better types, while second rate cattle took a slight ease from 5-15 c/kg.

Bullocks over 550kgs sold to 344c/kg to average 333c/kg, heavy steers 500-550kgs coming under slaughter & feeder competition reached 344c/kg to average 340c/kg, heavy heifers over 400kgs made to 328c/kg to average 302c/kg, heavy cows over 520kgs topped at 286c/kg to average 272c/kg, cows 450-520kgs made as much as 278c/kg to average 264c/kg, while bulls over 600kgs sold to 272c/kg. In the store section, heavy feeder steers 400-500kgssold to 362c/kg to average 327c/kg, 350-400kg steers topped at 368c/kg to average320c/kg, 280-350kg steers made as much as 432c/kg to average 348c/kg, 200-280kg weaner steers reached 458c/kg to average 347c/kg, with not enough Steers under200kgs to quote. Trade feeder heifers 350-400kgs sold to 330c/kg to average299c/kg, 280-350kg heifers topped at 320c/kg to average 275c/kg, weaner heifers 200-280kgs made as much as 296c/kg to average 273c/kg, while there were not enough heifers under 200kgs to quote. 53 cow & calf units were offered, the best of the young, crossbred cows & calves, medium frame, with calves from fresh-4 months old, sold to a top of \$1675/unit.
